



Part-Time Job Opportunity! Woonsocket Community Tree Advocate

Are you concerned about the excessive heat, high utility bills, flooding, and poor air quality? Do you want to get paid to lead a community-driven approach to these issues and enhance the health and well-being of your family, friends, and neighbors? Apply today to join the Green Infrastructure Center (GIC) in an effort to bring the benefits of trees to Woonsocket.

Position Summary: The Community Tree Advocate (CTA) provides community outreach and engagement with Woonsocket residents, businesses, organizations, and other stakeholders. This is a temporary and flexible part-time position expected to start in Spring 2026. The CTA will work closely with GIC Rhode Island staff to mobilize community members to plant trees and create opportunities to uplift voices on climate change and environmental justice issues. No prior background or experience is required. The ideal candidate has strong ties to the community and has lived in Woonsocket for several years. Must have a strong passion for improving the quality of life of their fellow community members. Ideal candidates live in the following neighborhoods: The Social District, Downtown Woonsocket, or Constitution Hill

Start Date: April or May 2026

Compensation: This position funds one individual \$28/hourly. The work schedule is flexible but may require availability on weekday evenings and some weekends. Expect to work an average 2-3 hours weekly with some variability depending on tasks and the candidate's availability. Anticipated bi-weekly pay of \$112 to \$168 (some pay periods will be more or less depending on the number of hours worked).
